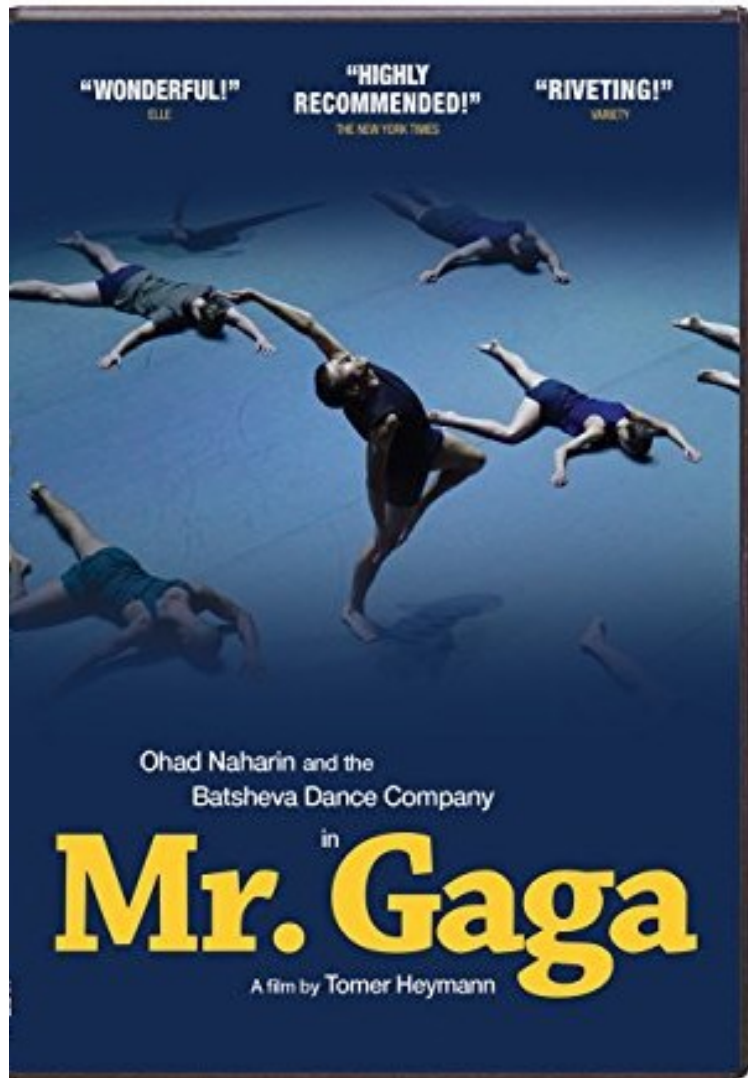




## North Country Reform Temple Jewish Film

Enter the world of Ohad Naharin and the Batsheva Dance Company. A man with extraordinary vision, Naharin is regarded as one of the most important choreographers in the world. He is known for developing “Gaga”, a movement language that resists labels, highlights somatic experiences, emphasizes improvisation and pushes dancers to use their bodies in ways that are ignored or overlooked by other dance techniques.

This award-winning documentary explores how Naharin’s movement has not only shaped contemporary Israeli dance, but has redefined the modern dance world at large. Filmed over 8 years, the film mixes intimate rehearsal footage with archival footage and breathtaking dance sequences.
